Reflect

Inform

You will need to report information or explain a concept or idea.

Analyze

You will need to interpret a text or a set of data to find connections and reach conclusions.

Analyze causes

You will need to identify probable causes of a trend or phenomenon and give evidence for your analysis.

Evaluate

You will need to determine whether something is good or bad based on criteria that you identify.

Argue

You will need to take a position on an issue or propose a course of action.
